Tobacco Growing Instructions

- 1. Fill seedling tray with 100% weed free seed raising mix.
- 2. Sprinkle very liberally with seed.
- 3. Place seedling trays in tray of water to keep the mix moist, top up daily.
- 4. Keep in a warm, semi shaded location.
- 5. The seeds should germinate in approx. 10 days.
- 6. At the 4 leaf stage (approx. 3-4 weeks) carefully pick out and transplant into individual pots.
- 7. Grow on in pots for a further 3 to 4 weeks.
- 8. Transplant into garden, 30cm apart in well prepared soil, rich in nutrients.
- 9. Tobacco plants grow very fast from this point and do best in full sun, sheltered position.
- 10. Plants will grow approx. 8ft/2.4m tall when fully grown.
- 11. Harvest leaves starting at the base of the plant, harvesting only the leaves that start to yellow.
- 12. Over the coming weeks harvest upwards on each plant.
- 13. The leaves can be hung in a dry place to air dry.
- 14. They will change colour to a rich golden brown and will have lost 90% of their moisture.
- 15. Remove the spine of the leaf, cut leaf tissue finely and start smoking for fee.
- 16. Germinates and grows well from September to May.
